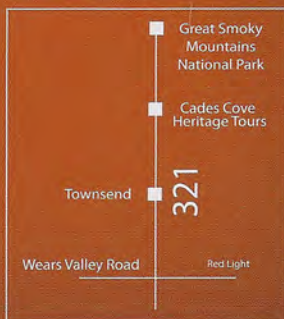
Tour Information
